This Dressage Rally is governed by The USPC Handbook and Rules for Dressage Competition 2018, the Annual Dressage Newsletter 2018, The USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Competition 2018, and The Uniform Officiating Rules of USPC.

ENTRY FEES:

\$90.00 per horse/rider combination and includes 1 night stabling. No charge for Stable Managers.

ALL Out of State Horses must have a current Negative Coggins in Compliance with your State Laws. Copy of which must be included with your entry forms.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. This rally is open to all Pony Club Members in good standing.
2. This rally will be held as a team competition.
 - * Teams will be composed of 3 or 4 riders and a stable manager.
NOTE: If you have a full team from your club – you will be required to supply your stable manager.
 - * Teams can be made up of riders with different certifications and competing in different divisions (levels).
 - * Scramble teams for competitors without a team will be created.
3. A rider competes at the level of his horse regardless of his/her certification.
4. This is a Championship Qualifying Rally – any rider attempting to qualify must have submitted an intent to qualify form by the deadline and is responsible for knowing all qualifying rules/criteria.
5. Regional Qualifying Criteria can be found on the Intermountain Regional Website.
6. Each qualifying rider will ride Tests 2 and 3 of their division and a Musical Freestyle, Pas de Deux, or Quadrille at the same level. Minimum score of 60% must be achieved on Test 3
8. Each non-qualifying rider will ride 2 tests from their division.

RECOMMENDED TESTS:

D1 - USDF Introductory Level Test A and USDF Introductory Level Test B

D2 - USDF Introductory Level Test B and USDF Introductory Level Test C

D3 - USEF Training Level Test 1 and USEF Training Level Test 2

C and Above - Any Level of USDF or USEF Dressage Tests

ARENAS:

Introductory and Training Level will be ridden in a small arena (20 meters x 40 meters).

First Level and Up, Musical Freestyles, Pas de Deux, Quadrilles will be ridden in a standard arena (20 meters x 60 meters).

MUSIC:

All recorded music must be submitted on a CD. It is highly recommended that all competitors make a back-up copy of their music. The CD's must be labeled with the competitor's name and turned in when registration packets are picked up. Sound checks may be done between 7:00 pm and 8:00 pm on Friday evening or between 7:00am and 8:00 am on Saturday morning. If desired, each competitor may have 1 representative in the sound booth to play the tape. If the rider waives this right, it is his/her responsibility to notify the sound system operator by a hand signal to start the tape.

ATTIRE:

Attire for C1's and higher AND any rider attempting to qualify for championships must be either correctly informal or formal. Attire for non-qualifying D rated competitors must be neat, clean, and workmanlike. USPC approved (SEI/ASTM) helmets and appropriate footwear are mandatory for ALL riders. Pony club pins must be worn. Medical Armbands or Bracelets with all required information must be worn at all times.

HORSE MANAGEMENT:

Horse Management will be judged for the duration of the rally.

Each team will need to set up a tack room using their trailers.

**** Tack Rooms will be located in Barn Area and will NOT be accessible before or after barn hours OR available for sleeping accommodations!**

Feed Rooms will not be provided. Teams may use an extra trailer for all feed OR hay may be bagged or securely covered (inaccessible to horses) and placed on ground in front of tack rooms and concentrates/supplements may be placed inside of Tack Room Trailers (existing tack rooms in front of trailers may also be used). See HM Rulebook for specifications.

SCORING:

1. Riding Score - a positive point score (i.e. 60.285% = 60.285 points).

2. Horse Management Scores = (HM Penalties) X (# of Rounds) X 3

3. Final Score = Riding Score – HM Score

AWARDS:

Team Ribbons through 6th.

Horse Management Ribbons for top 3 teams.

Individual Ribbons through 3rd for each division.

COACHING:

Coaching is permitted at a USPC Dressage Rally. Coaches must sign enclosed Guidelines for Coaching form and include with entries.

VOLUNTEERS:

Please send the names of at least 2 volunteers per club. If there is a job preference, please list or email the organizer. Volunteers CANNOT be the designated team coaches.

CHAPERONES:

Each club must provide 1 designated chaperone at least 21 years old for EVERY team. The chaperone must remain on the grounds for the duration of the rally. The enclosed Chaperone's duties form must be filled out and signed by each chaperone and returned with your entry. Please list the names of the competitors each chaperone is responsible for on the form by the signature.

STABLING:

Stabling fees are included for Friday night in your entries and will be in 12'x12' metal panel pens over dirt/grass. Shavings will not be provided but will be available for purchase. You are responsible for the care of your horse and for stripping stalls or cleaning pens before you leave. If you need additional stabling, 12'x12' panel pens will be available for \$15 per night per horse at Southwind Ranch.

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 84, take Jerome exit #168.

If you were East bound turn right, if you were West bound turn left. You will be turning away from WalMart and towards Subway. Go past Subway and take the first right which is 300 S Road. (Do not take a right at Bob Barton which is just past the eastbound freeway exit.) Go approx ¾ of a mile to Southwind Ranch. You will see a sign at the driveway. Enter and go through metal gate.
