## ENTRY FEES:

**EARLY BIRD PRICE:** \$90.00 per horse/rider combination if entered/postmarked on or before June 18th. Any incomplete Early Bird entries are NOT eligible for discount. All paperwork, fees, and signatures must accompany the Early Bird entry for it to receive the discounted rate.

**REGULAR PRICE:** \$100.00 per horse/rider combination if entered/postmarked between June 19th and July 2nd.

Stabling for Wednesday night is included. Competitors may arrive Wednesday between 3:00 and 9:00 pm.

**REFUND POLICY:** No refunds after July 2, 2019 unless accompanied by a valid doctor's or veterinarian's note. In this case the entry fee, less a \$50.00 office fee, will be refunded to the club.

**ALL Out of State Horses must have a current Negative Coggins in Compliance with your State Laws. Copy of which must be included with your entry forms.**

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. This rally is open to all Pony Club Members in good standing.
2. This rally will be held as a team competition.
  - \* Teams will be composed of 3 or 4 riders and a stable manager.  
**NOTE: If you have a full team from your club – you will be required to supply your stable manager.**
  - \* Teams can be made up of riders with different certifications and competing in different divisions.
  - \* Scramble teams for competitors without a team will be created.
3. A rider competes at the level of his horse regardless of his/her certification.
4. Each rider will ride 2 tests from their division.

**RULES:** This Dressage Rally is governed by The USPC Handbook and Rules for Dressage Competition 2019, the Annual Dressage Newsletter 2019, The USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Competition 2019, and The Uniform Officiating Rules of USPC.

**DIVISIONS (LEVELS):**

Introductory, Training, First and Up

**ALLOWED TESTS:**

2019 USDF Introductory Level Tests

2019 USEF Tests for Training-Fourth Level

**\*\*NO USEA (Eventing) TESTS WILL BE ALLOWED AT THIS RALLY\*\***

**RECOMMENDED TESTS:**

*D1* - USDF Introductory Level Test A and USDF Introductory Level Test B

*D2* - USDF Introductory Level Test B and USDF Introductory Level Test C

*D3* - USEF Training Level Test 1 and USEF Training Level Test 2

*C and Above* - Any Level of USDF or USEF Dressage Tests

**ARENAS:**

Introductory and Training Level will be ridden in a small arena (20 meters x 40 meters).

First Level and Up will be ridden in a standard arena (20 meters x 60 meters).

**ATTIRE:**

Schooling (polo shirts and breeches) or Dressage Competition Attire is acceptable. USPC approved (SEI/ASTM) helmets and appropriate footwear are mandatory for ALL riders. Medical Armbands or Bracelets with all required information must be worn at all times.

**HORSE MANAGEMENT:**

Horse Management will be judged for the duration of the rally.

Each team will need to set up a tack room using their trailers.

**\*\* Tack Rooms will be located in Barn Area and will NOT be accessible before or after barn hours OR available for sleeping accommodations!**

Feed Rooms will not be provided. Teams may use an extra trailer for all feed OR hay may be bagged or securely covered (inaccessible to horses) and placed on ground in front of tack rooms and concentrates/supplements may be placed inside of Tack Room Trailers (existing tack rooms in front of trailers may also be used). See HM Rulebook for specifications.

**COACHING:**

Coaching is permitted at a USPC Dressage Rally. Coaches must sign enclosed Guidelines for Coaching form and include with entries.

**CHAPERONE OR EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM:**

Each club must provide 1 designated chaperone at least 21 years old for EVERY team. The chaperone must remain on the grounds for the duration of the rally. The Chaperone's duties form must be filled out and signed by each chaperone and returned with your entry. Please list the names of the competitors each chaperone is responsible for on the form by the signature. For adults – please submit the Emergency Contact Form.

**VOLUNTEERS:**

Please send the names of at least 2 volunteers per club. If there is a job preference, please list or email the organizer. Volunteers CANNOT be the designated team coaches.

**STABLING:**

Stabling will be available for Dressage Rally Competitors only and is included in the entry fee. Stabling includes Wednesday night through Thursday at conclusion of Dressage Rally. **If you are not participating in Eventing Camp – due to the limited amount of stabling at Winter Sun Horse Park – you will need to move your mount off-site by Thursday night.** Off-site stabling can be arranged at River Sage Stables for \$20/night by calling Sarah at 208.316.1212.

On-site stabling will be in outside pipe pens with no shavings. Shavings are available for purchase at The Valley Country Store in Bellevue, however they are not required. Tack and feed rooms will be set up in trailers. Parents must pack to be independent of their trailers. Trailers, if used in the rally, may not be used as sleeping accommodations. Horses must wear leather or break away halters at all time in the stalls. Stalls need to be cleaned very well prior to leaving!

### SCORING:

1. Overall Score = Riding Score + HM Bonus Score
2. Riding Score - a positive point score (i.e. 60.285% = 60.285 points).
3. For a two-round rally - HM Bonus Score = 150 — (Total HM Penalties X 1.5)

### AWARDS:

Team Ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup>.  
Horse Management Ribbons for top 3 teams.  
Individual Ribbons through 3rd for each division.

### WEATHER:

It gets COLD here at night, even in the summer! Low 40's and even 30's are possible. Daytime temps will be in the 80's or 90's.

### FOOD:

**NO food will be provided.** You are responsible for your own food during the camp. Water stations will be setup throughout the site. Bring your own water bottle to refill and keep with you. **WATER IN THE STABLING AREA IS NOT POTABLE AND SHOULD NOT BE CONSUMED.** The town of Bellevue is only 5 minutes away with convenience stores, grocery store, and restaurants.

### ACCOMODATIONS:

Campers and chaperones are strongly encouraged to camp on the grounds. It greatly enhances the children's rally experience, helps them make wonderful regional friends and provides them with lasting memories! Primitive camping is available in the field. No RV hook ups are available, but there is space for RV parking.

Farm is first property on the right at 26 Townsend Gulch Road and parking is behind the hay barn. **PLEASE RESPECT THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 25MPH ON BROADFORD AND TOWNSEND ROADS!!!! ORGANIZER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ASK PARTICIPANTS TO LEAVE IF SPEED LIMIT IF NOT OBEYED.**
