Join us for four fabulous, fun days of camp. You will have the opportunity to see old friends and make new ones while participating in Cross Country, Jumping, Dressage, and Horse Management lessons. Our focus is on preparing for Rallies and Certifications later this year. Come learn with us!

Camp will be at Storey Tails at Once Upon A Horse, with the Cross Country option at nearby Spur Wing Stables. Storey Tails is the home base for Boise Pony Club and boasts 3 full-size outdoor arenas, an indoor arena, 16 covered stalls and 10 pipe panel stalls available for Camp!

**LATE ENTRIES WILL BE PENALIZED BY A \$25.00 LATE FEE**

Entries are limited and will be on a first come first served basis. Entries must include payment to be considered as complete.

**\*\*\*NOTE\*\*\*** *This entry is being sent only to DC's and club officers. The DC is responsible for distributing it to club members. Entries must be submitted online INDIVIDUALLY using the Google Form <https://forms.gle/vKxZWNLKxc3nquCr8>. Payment can be sent via Cash, Check made out to Boise Pony Club, or Venmo to @BoisePony-Club.*

**ENTRY FEES:**

\$250.00 per horse/rider combination. \$100 for Horseless. *Stabling for Thursday through Saturday nights is included.* Check in on Thursday at noon. Wednesday or Sunday night stabling is \$25 extra per night.

ALL Horses must have proof of flu/rhino vaccinations within the past 6 months, a current Negative Coggins, and a brand inspection in compliance with state law.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** No refunds for cancellations after June 12, 2024 unless accompanied by a valid doctor's note (for either the horse or rider).

**TEAMS:** All Campers will be divided into teams by the Organizer.

**CHAPERONES:** Each club MUST have at least one designated chaperone per 6 riders, at least 21 years old, on the grounds at all times during the camp.

**T SHIRTS:** All Campers will receive a T Shirt with their entry. Please indicate your preferred size (unisex) on the entry form. Additional T-Shirts can be purchased at a cost of \$20 per T Shirt. We will do our best to get the size requested, but **specific sizes are not guaranteed.**

**CROSS COUNTRY CLINICS** Will be offered on Thursday morning at the following levels for an additional \$35 (facility fee for Spur Wing cross country course):

- **Grasshopper:** Groundpoles to 18" (cross rails and some natural obstacles)
- **Intro:** 2'3" (may include water and ditches)
- **Beginner Novice:** 2'7" (may include water and ditches)
- **Novice:** 2'11" (may include water and ditches)

**TENTATIVE SCHEDULE** The Camp will include:

- Thursday
  - Optional Group Cross Country Lessons starting Thursday morning
  - Camp Opens at 12:00 noon
  - Stall set up, crafts and games
- Friday
  - Group Show Jumping and Dressage Lessons (one in the morning, one in the afternoon)
  - Horse Management stations
  - Arts and Crafts
- Saturday
  - Mock Derby with dressage in the morning, show jumping in the afternoon
  - MORE Horse Management mini-stations and activities
  - Pool & Pizza Party
- Sunday
  - Camp summary, awards and clean up

**STABLING AND TACKROOMS:** Stabling will be in temporary, covered stalls or non-covered pipe panel stalls. Initial bedding will be provided, and more can be brought or purchased at D&B Supply in Garden City if desired. Tack and feed rooms will be set up in trailers that need to be provided by your clubs. Parents must pack to be independent of their trailers. Trailers, if used in the camp, may not be used as sleeping accommodations. Horses must wear leather or break away halters at all times in the stalls. **Stalls need to be stripped prior to leaving.**

**SET UP:** Campers may arrive to set-up after 12:00pm on Thursday.

**ATTIRE:** Schooling attire - sleeved polo shirts (no tank tops) and breeches - is acceptable. Vests are required for Cross Country at all levels. **All campers must wear a medical armband with a current signed medical release form inserted or a medical bracelet at all times when on the grounds. They will not be allowed to compete in the Camp without this armband and form or bracelet.**

**REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:** As listed for overnight rallies in the 2023 USPC Horse Management Handbook.

**LONGEING:** Longeing must follow USPC Standards and Safety Procedures and only may be done with the consent of the Organizer. Longeing is only allowed during the time designated by the Organizer and in the designated longeing area.

**GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES:**

- It will be hot during the day so please be prepared with ways to hydrate and cool yourself down. **Don't forget sunscreen!**
- This camp will run similarly to a rally, with Opening and Closing times for the Barns, proper stall and tack room set-ups, and inspections done prior to mounting your horses. However, this is a learning experience and we encourage parents to be involved, see how it's run, and learn alongside your child! Since they will not have your assistance at a true rally, encouraging independence and teamwork with horse care, tacking up, etc would be appropriate and beneficial.
- **Dogs allowed but MUST BE LEASHED.**

**FOOD:** Snacks and water-filling stations will be provided, but no meals other than at the Saturday night pool party. You are responsible for your own food during the camp. Water stations will be set up throughout the site. Bring your own water bottle to refill and keep with you. Shopping is only 10 minutes away with convenience stores, grocery stores, and restaurants.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Campers and chaperones are strongly encouraged to camp on the grounds. It greatly enhances the children's camp experience, helps them make wonderful regional friends and provides them with lasting memories! Primitive camping is available in the field. No RV hook ups/plug-ins are available, but there is space for RV parking. No dumping of grey water please!

**DIRECTIONS:**

**To Storey Tails at Once Upon a Horse:** From I-84 take Exit 46 north toward ID-55 N/S Eagle Road. You will travel approximately 8.6 miles. Turn right into the yard and follow the directions for parking. Address: 3000 N Eagle Rd, Eagle, ID

**From Storey Tails to Spur Wing Stables Cross Country Course:** Head south on Eagle Rd toward Beacon Light Rd. Turn right onto Beacon Light Rd, travel approximately 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Linder Rd, travel approximately 3.3 miles. Turn right onto Duck Alley Road, travel approximately ¼ mile. Follow the signs for parking in the field. (Google maps will take you to the house, not parking) Address: 2333 W Duck Alley, Eagle, ID
