The DC must submit entries online and mail payment and all required forms.

This Show Jumping Rally is governed by The USPC Handbook and Rules for Show Jumping Competition 2024, the Show Jumping Spring Newsletter 2024, The USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Competition 2024, and The Uniform Officiating Rules of USPC.

ENTRY FEES:

\$120.00 per horse/rider combination and includes 1 night stabling. No charge for Stable Managers. Make checks payable to: Magic Valley Pony Club (MVPC) and send with entries to:

ALL Out of State Horses must have a current Negative Coggins in Compliance with your State Laws. A copy of which must be included with your entry forms.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. This rally is open to all Pony Club Members in good standing.
2. This rally will be held as a team competition.
 - * Teams will be composed of 3 or 4 riders and a stable manager.
NOTE: If your club has a full team– you are required to supply your team's stable manager.
Riding stable managers C1 & up are allowed.
 - * Teams can be made up of riders with different certifications and competing in different divisions.
 - * Scramble teams for competitors without a team will be created.
3. A rider competes at the level of his horse regardless of his/her certification.
4. A horse can only compete in 1 division.
5. A rider/horse combination will ride in 3 classes in their division.
6. The organizer will draw for the starting order June 20th .

DIVISIONS (LEVELS):

Mini Groundpole – (to be in smaller arena up top – 6 fences only)
Cross Rail (18")
Beginning Jumpers (2')
Sm/Med Ponies (2'3")
.75m Jumpers (2'5")
.85m Jumpers (2'9")
.95m Pony Jumpers (3'1")
.95m Jumpers (3'1")
1.05m Jumpers (3'5")
1.15m Jumpers (3'9")

CLASSES:

ALL Divisions will have 3 Rounds scored as Knock Down.

ALL Divisions will also have an Equitation Score for Round 2

Mini Groundpole, Cross Rail, Beginner Jumpers, Sm/Med Ponies and .75 Jumpers

Round 3 will be based on Optimum Time.

.85 and Up – Round 3 will include a Jump Off run according to Table II 2(a).

SPEED:

Mini Groundpole, Cross Rail, = 200 mpm

Beginner Jumpers = 250 mpm

Sm/Med Ponies, .75m Jumpers, .85m Jumpers = 325 mpm

.95m Jumpers and up = 350 mpm

COMPETITION ARENA:

Mini Groundpole division will be in 90' x 70' dirt outdoor arena.

All other divisions will take place in a sandy/soil outdoor arena measuring approx. 160' x 220'.

ATTIRE:

Competition Attire for Show Jumping is allowed and Basic Riding Attire for Show Jumping is required for all riders (page 11/12 in SJ Rulebook). USPC approved (SEI/ASTM) helmets are mandatory for ALL riders. Medical Armband or bracelet with required information must be worn at all times. See Horse Management Rulebook for more information.

HORSE MANAGEMENT:

Horse Management will be judged for the duration of the rally.

Each team will need to set up a tack room using their trailers.

** Tack Rooms will be located in Barn Area and will NOT be accessible before or after barn hours
OR available for sleeping accommodations!

Feed Rooms will not be provided. Teams may use an extra trailer for all feed OR hay may be bagged or securely covered (inaccessible to horses) and placed on ground in front of tack rooms.

Concentrates/supplements may be placed inside of Tack Room Trailers (existing tack rooms in front of trailers may also be used). See HM rulebook for specifications on feed.

SCORING:

1. Riding Score– faults accumulated from the 3 rounds will be totaled. Equitation, Jump Off scores, and Optimum Time scores (bonus points) will then be subtracted.

2. Horse Management Score = (HM Penalties) X (# of Rounds) x 0.2

3. Final Score = Riding Score + HM Score – Lowest score wins

AWARDS:

Team Ribbons through 6th.

Horse Management Ribbons for top 3 teams.

Individual Ribbons through 3rd for each division.

COACHING:

A coach MUST accompany each team. No competitor may jump in a warm-up arena without a coach present. The coach and the chaperone shall not be the same person. Coaches must sign the Coach's Form

VOLUNTEERS:

Please send the names of at least 2 volunteers per club. If there is a job preference, please list or email the organizer. Volunteers CANNOT be coaches.

CHAPERONES FOR PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF MAJORITY:

Each club must provide 1 designated chaperone at least 21 years old for every team with members under the age of majority. Chaperones must remain on the grounds for the duration of the rally. The enclosed Chaperone's duties form must be filled out and signed by each chaperone. Please list the names of the competitors each chaperone is responsible for at the bottom of the form.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS OVER THE AGE OF MAJORITY FOR YOUR STATE:

Every adult participant must submit an Emergency Contact Form.

JR/SR TEAM FORMATION:

If JR (17 & Under) and SR (18 & Up) competitors will be on a team together – the JR/SR Team Acknowledgement Form must be filled out by every JR Competitor on that team.

STABLING:

Stabling fees are included for Saturday night in your entries and will be in 12'x12' metal panel pens over dirt/grass. Shavings will not be provided but will be available for purchase at the local D & B store in Jerome. You are responsible for the care of your horse and for stripping stalls or cleaning pens before you leave. If you need additional stabling, 12'x12' panel pens will be available for \$20 per night per horse at Southwind Ranch.

At Southwind Ranch

You can camp at Southwind Ranch in the field.

There are porta potties, but NO electricity.

Horse trailers used as tack/feed rooms in barn area may not be used for accommodations.

FOOD:

No food will be available! Pack your own or Wal-Mart & fast-food locations available within 2 miles.

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 84, take Jerome exit #168.

If you were East bound turn right, if you were West bound turn left. You will be turning towards the Maverick Gas Station. Go past Maverick and take the first right, which is 300 S Road. Go approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to Southwind Ranch. You will see a sign at the driveway. Enter and go through metal gate.

MISC:

No dogs allowed.

Smoking or open flames are not allowed anywhere on the grounds.
