**ENTRY FEES:**

\$100 per horse/rider combination (includes stabling *on Saturday night*)

If you would like to arrive Saturday, you can check in after 6pm.

Make checks payable to: Sawtooth Pony Club (SPC) or VENMO available

ALL Out of State Horses must have a current Negative Coggins in compliance with state law. ALL Horses must have a brand inspection in compliance with state law.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** No refunds for cancellations after June 17, 2022 unless accompanied by a valid doctor's note (for either the horse or rider).

**TEAMS:** Consist of 3 or 4 riders and a Stable Manager. Stable Managers may be any rating.

If your club does not have a complete team, either call other clubs to make up a scrambled team, or send in such entries to be placed on scrambled teams by the Organizer. Do not hesitate to enter if you do not have a full team.

**CHAPERONES:** Each club MUST have at least one designated chaperone, at least 21 years old, on the grounds at all times during the rally. The chaperone may not be a coach. A chaperone may be responsible for only one club.

**VOLUNTEERS:** Each club must supply two adult volunteers. Please send the volunteer names along with your entry paperwork.

**COACHING:** Each team MUST be accompanied by a coach. No competitor may jump in a warm-up arena without a coach present. The coach and the chaperone shall not be the same person. Coaches must sign the coach's form and include with your entries.

**RALLY KITS:** Each Team must supply own

**LONGEING:** Longeing must follow USPC Standards and Safety Procedures and only may be done with the consent of the CHMJ. Longeing is only allowed during the time designated by the CHMJ and in the designated longeing area.

**DIVISIONS:** Competitors may choose their Division regardless of their rating level (with the exception of the Junior Division). Junior Division is an optional division for Unrated and D1's only and is meant as an educational introduction to rallying for our youngest members.

**Junior Pony Clubbers:** Teams will include 3-4 "riders" and a Stable Manager. The Stable Manager can be an older Pony Clubber. They will "manage" only 1 horse on their team and the care will be shared by all team members. The riding portions of the rally will be competed on Stick Horses in the Ground Poles Division.

#### **DIVISIONS (LEVELS):**

**Mini Groundpole – (to be in smaller arena up top – 6 fences only)**

**Cross Rail**

**Introductory: 2'6"**

**Small/Medium Ponies : 2'-2'9", ponies not to exceed 13.2 hands**

**Large Ponies :3'-3'3", 13.2 to 14.2 hands**

**Developing Horse/Rider : 2'9"-3'**

**Horse I : 3'-3'3"**

**Horse III : 3'6"-3'9"**

**Horse II : 3'3"3'6"**

**Horse IV : 3'9"-4'**

#### **TENTATIVE CLASSES:**

All Classes will be run under USPC Show Jumping Rules Articles 30 and 34. Ties will not be broken. Jump-offs will not be held unless noted (Jump Off) and will run according to Table II 2(a).

**STABLING AND TACK ROOMS:** Stabling will be in outside pipe pens with no shavings. Shavings are available for purchase at Valley Country Store in Bellevue. Tack and feed rooms will be set up in trailers. Parents must pack to be independent of their trailers. Trailers, if used in the rally, may not be used as sleeping accommodations. Horses must wear leather or break away halters at all times in the stalls. **Stalls must be stripped before leaving and panels MUST be broken down.**

**SET UP:** Teams which arrive early may unload equipment, but MAY NOT begin to set up before 6pm on Saturday. Be sure to arrive enough ahead of the Official Rally Opening to have your horses settled and your stalls and tack room completely set up by 8am Sunday.

**ATTIRE:**

**Schooling (polo shirts and breeches) is acceptable. Informal or Formal attire is acceptable.**

**USPC approved(SEI/ASTM) helmets and appropriate footwear are mandatory for ALL riders. Medical Armbands or Bracelets with all required information must be worn at all times.**

**REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:** As listed for overnight rallies in the 2021 USPC Horse Management Handbook. Be sure to bring everything on the list! You will be penalized for missing items! All competitors must wear a medical armband with a current signed medical release form inserted or a medical bracelet at all times when on the grounds. They will not be allowed to compete in the Rally without this armband and form or bracelet.

**AWARDS:** Team Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Individual Ribbons per Division to 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Team Horse Management Ribbons to 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Sportsmanship Award.

**GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES:**

It gets COLD here at night, even in the summer! Low 40's and even 30's are possible. Daytime temps will be in the 80's or 90's.

**FOOD:** **NO food will be provided.** You are responsible for your own food during the rally. Water stations will be set up throughout the site. Bring your own water bottle to refill and keep with you. The town of Bellevue is only 5 minutes away with convenience stores, grocery store, and restaurants.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Competitors and chaperones are strongly encouraged to camp on the grounds. It greatly enhances the children's rally experience, helps them make wonderful regional friends and provides them with lasting memories! Primitive camping is available in the field. No RV hook ups are available, but there is space for RV parking.
